- Inova Loudoun Hospital attained Nursing Magnet re-designation recognition through the
 American Nurses Credentialing Center. This award recognizes excellence in nursing. This is the
 highest honor an organization can receive for professional nursing practice, and is held by only
 8% of hospitals nationwide. Inova Loudoun was initially designated a Magnet hospital in 2006,
 and has been re-designated every four years since based on adherence to Magnet concepts and
